Statistics Canada releases 2022 donor data

Based on charitable donations <u>reported</u> by individuals on their tax returns.

The 2022 numbers show that 17% of Canadian tax filers declared making charitable donations, 0.3% fewer than a year earlier. The total amount of reported donations fell for the first time since 2016, decreasing 3.1% to \$11.4 billion. This decrease in total donations followed the previous year's increase of 11.5%.
